Six churches partnered with SU Singapore to raise up a new generation of children's workers in Myanmar. SU's trip to Yangon from October 4 to 8 was jointly sponsored by Barker Road Methodist Church, Bethesda Cathedral, Grace Methodist Church, RiverLife Church, Queenstown Baptist Church and Yio Chu Kang Chapel.



As a result of their missions partnership, the SU Singapore team - David Leong and three other trainers - Ruth Tan, Edna Low and Daniel Teu, was able to train 81 Sunday School teachers and caregivers from 25 churches and Christian organisations, including orphanages and pre-schools from different townships including all the way from up north in Mandalay.



The 3-day Sunday School Teachers' Conference was jointly organised by Scripture Union Myanmar and Church of God in Myanmar (Evangelical).

The participants were well engaged throughout the conference, as demonstrated by their enthusiastic response and active participation in discussions, games and a repertoire of high-energy action songs. Pastor Shelly Win, Assistant Pastor of Church of God in Myanmar (Evangelical) said, "All the participants said that the conference was excellent. They found the training very encouraging and helpful, making them more effective in Children's Ministry. They are requesting for more training next year."
